Dear Mr. Connolly,

I wish to advise you of the commencement of industrial action up to and including a series of strike actions by members of this Union in the Civil Service with effect from **Wednesday 27 January 2010**. This action arises from the Government's decision to cut our members' pay and the threats to make further cuts in pay, pension benefits and jobs. This action will continue until the pay cuts are reversed, the threats to make further cuts are withdrawn and guarantees are given that such cuts will not take place.

The action will include some or all of the following and no further notice of action will be given :

- Members will work to rule and all goodwill will be withdrawn
- Refusal to carry out certain duties
- Refusal to carry out duties of higher grades without payment of appropriate allowance
- Strict adherence to Health and Safety procedures and requirements
- Refusal to prepare responses to Parliamentary Questions and Ministerial representations
- Strict adherence to traditional reporting relationships
- Strict operation of attendances including closure of offices outside of certain core time periods and refusal to attend beyond normal hours
- Refusal to co-operate with any work changes and, in particular, refusal to co-operate with any aspect of the so-called transformation agenda
- Refusal to give priority to queries by elected representatives
- Strike action in the event of any member being subjected to disciplinary action because they are participating in this industrial action
- Work stoppages and strikes on a selective and/or ongoing basis.

The Union may also withdraw from some or all Partnership structures.

These actions may be taken for a period and/or escalated or reduced without further notice and may be taken by members of this Union alone or in co-operation with members of other unions.

I want to emphasise that if any attempt is made to victimise any member of this Union either to prevent their participation in this action or as a consequence of their participation, the Union reserves the right to escalate the action immediately including a series of strike actions which might be on a selective or general basis. In such situations, no further notice will be given.
