Building Momentum Extension

In summary the pay deal that was agreed in October provides for an additional 6.5% over the years 2022 and 2023. Of which 3% was backdated to the 2nd February 2022 and has already been paid to members.

In 2023, a 2% increase is due from the 1st March and a further 1.5% (or 750 euro whichever is the greater) from the 1st of October.

AHCPS Income Continuance Scheme



The AHCPS Income Continuance Scheme provides great value at only 0.57% of gross salary and is tax deductible.

If you do not already have the cover it is important to consider taking it out as an individual can be on half pay after an illness absence of three months or where an accumulation of three months arises within a four-year period.

Cornmarket Insurance have also informed the Association that all eligible AHCPS members will get 6 Months' FREE Income Continuance* cover when they apply to join for the first time before 31st December 2022. Please note, if you have previously been a member of the FORSA Income Continuance Scheme to ensure you and your family are protected you must join the AHCPS scheme, as the FORSA Scheme may not cover you.

Association's 80th Anniversary 2023

In the last couple of years, several milestones have been reached: Membership is at an all-time high of nearly 4,000 and is growing every month.

The Association has for the first time more female members than male. In addition, the Executive Committee now has a 50:50 gender balance.
